## Ringer's Planning Meeting held at Iffley (6) on Saturday 21<sup>st</sup> November

After having packed the pre-requested method ringing, and more, into a very well attended 75 minute practice on the Iffley bells, the morning was rounded off with a planning meeting for an array of ringing events throughout the forthcoming year. We were extremely gratified to have our new Guild Steward, Tony Crabtree, in attendance and huge thanks are due to Susan and Simon King for yet again hosting our informal gathering and providing a generous array of refreshments. Our get-together may have owed more to the informal ambience of a 'cottage industry' rather than 'corporate' formality, but the focus on providing a broad spectrum of social and educational ringing opportunities in 2016 was not in the least bit blurred or diminished. The meeting marked the climax of a year where virtually every event we posited back at our January gathering came to fruition, and the bare few which didn't were due to circumstances beyond our control rather than lack of support. Although our set-up is nebulous in that it has no name or official status, the primary aim is clear in it being a regular practical resource for ringers in Oxford and beyond to access as a supplement to that which they may be trying to learn on practice nights or as a primer for the Guild ringing courses. Hopefully the facts and figures listed below should amply illustrate what we have been doing in 2015.

### The Marston Bells are back!

On the afternoon of Friday 6<sup>th</sup> December a short service was held at St Nicholas Church, Old Marston to celebrate the rehanging and initial

ringing of its refurbished peal of six bells. The Tower Captain, Anthony Hughes welcomed the bell hangers from White's of Appleton, Marston and Oxford City Branch ringers, and visitors to this rare occasion. The Vicar and his wife, Tony and Alison Price, were unable to attend and sent their apologies. Anthony gave a brief history of the peal of bells at Marston and of the ringing, finishing with heartfelt thanks to all the people who helped to raise funds over the last three years to enable the refurbishment to take place. He highlighted the enormous contribution made by the previous tower captain, the late Roy Jones, who not only started ringing at Marston in 1948 continuing until 2014, but also made a financial pledge to complete the rehang.



After a minute's silence to remember that St Nicholas Church had housed a peal of bells for nearly two centuries, the Curate, the Rev. Rob Glennie, read the Belfry Office. A band including the Appleton ringers rang a couple of extents of Stedman Doubles on the bells, and then making a few small adjustments afterwards. Finally, the Marston and City Branch ringers undertook the ringing of several extents. It was announced that a formal Dedication Service would be arranged in 2016 and the health of future ringers of the peal was celebrated with a glass of wine! **Anthony Hughes**
